Meetings an Opportunity for Discussion on Industry Dynamics, Center Resources

Harrisburg, Pa. – Dairy producers as well as others serving and supporting the dairy industry are encouraged to attend one of six Dairy Industry Professional Roundtable Meetings hosted by the Center for Dairy Excellence in six counties across Pennsylvania.

“Pennsylvania’s dairy industry is in a state of transition, and these meetings are intended to be a forum for dairy producers and industry professionals to talk about the factors shaping the industry and its future,” said Jayne Sebright, executive director of the Center for Dairy Excellence. “The meetings will include a look at how the Center can be a resource to farms working to find solutions in an ever-changing and challenging marketplace.”
