Study to Support Growth and Competitiveness of Pennsylvania's Dairy Industry

The Center for Dairy Excellence and Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture are supporting a study to analyze strategic options to enhance the growth and competitiveness of Pennsylvania's dairy industry. The study has multiple components focused on milk production, dairy processing, marketing and policy. The study will be managed by Chuck Nicholson (Penn State), Andy Novakovic (Cornell) and Mark Stephenson (University of Wisconsin), who will seek information and input from a broad range of the state's dairy industry stakeholders.

Data assessment: What data are not currently available (or readily accessible in decision-useful form) would be helpful to support decision-making by industry stakeholders in Pennsylvania?

Current Programs and Policies: What state-level programs or policies support future growth and competitiveness of the Pennsylvania dairy industry?

What limits future growth of milk production or processing capacity in Pennsylvania and what could the state do to lessen those constraints?
