## DE DAIRY MARKETS & MANAGEMENT UPDATE

- JULY 2, 2024 -

May margin and look ahead: May's Dairy Margin Coverage (DMC) margin closed out at \$10.52 per hundredweight (cwt), \$1.02 over the \$9.50 maximum coverage level and did not trigger indemnities at any coverage level. May's margin jumped 92 cents per cwt from April's margin at \$9.60. Year-over-year, May's margin shot up from 2023, when it was at \$4.83 per cwt to \$10.52, a \$5.69 increase. May 2024's U.S. average all-milk price came in at \$22.00 per cwt, which was up \$1.50 from last

Year-over-year, alfalfa hay price is down \$41.00 per ton from May 2023 at \$423.58 to May 2024 at \$388.65. January through May 2024 corn costs are the lowest they have been since February 2021 at \$4.75 per bushel. Soybean meal (SBM) sat at \$388.65 per ton, a \$30.97 jump from April that broke the five-consecutive-month decline from December 2023 to April 2024. However, May 2024's SBM is down \$34.93 per ton from May 2023 and \$52.63 from May 2022.

month and up \$2.70 from last May.

Across the board, alfalfa hay, corn, and SBM costs are up month-over-month, which resulted in total feed costs increasing 58 cents per cwt from April to May 2024. This is a significant bump from the steady decline from January 2024 at \$11.62 per cwt to April 2024 at \$10.90. Based on the DMC Online Decision Tool (updated June 26, 2024),

if margins continue to climb as forecasted, indemnities will not be triggered at any coverage levels. Based on June's Decision Tool, projected margins will increase over the coming months and peak in October at \$13.71 per cwt, up 61 cents from May's Decision Tool's projection of \$13.10. The forecasted margins then dip to \$13.58 per cwt in November and close out the year at \$13.15 in December. Previously, May 2022's margin at \$12.51 per cwt held the highest margin for the past five program years. If the projected margins for the remainder of the year hold true, August through December would surpass the previous peak margin.

From the forecast for June's DMC margin, estimated to come in at \$10.55 per cwt, feed cost projections fall to \$10.27 in Sep-

tember, then rise to \$10.48 in both November and December. Compared to program

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year 2023, the 2024 average projected feed costs would be \$3.37 per cwt higher. The remaining months' all milk prices are forecasted to jump to \$22.65 per cwt in June, dip slightly into July to \$22.60, steadily increasing to \$24.06 in November, then drop to \$23.63. The remainder of program year 2024 is projected to average \$23.40. For DMC indemnities to be triggered, either the all-milk prices would have to drop, or feed costs would need to close the space between the all-milk price and the price floor.

Based on the NASS milk production report, U.S. milk production for May 2024 came in at approximately 19.7 billion pounds, down 0.9% year-over-year-over-year. 2024 production per cow averaged 2,105 pounds, down 3 pounds from a year ago. Milk cow numbers were also down from May 2023 by 68,000 head to 9.35 million head for May 2024. Pennsylvania milk production followed a similar trend with May 2024 production at 856 million pounds, down 0.9% from 2023. Milk per cow closed out the month at 1,840 pounds per cow, down 0.8% from May 2023. Milk cow numbers were down 0.2% from a year ago to May 2024 at 465,000 head.

Looking at the May NASS cold storage report, year-over-year, refrigerated warehouse-stored cheese stocks dropped 4% from May 2023 to 1.4 billion pounds in May 2024. Conversely, May 2024 butter stocks closed out at approximately 380 million pounds, up month-over-month by by a 5% and up 3% from May 2023. Our next "Protecting Your Profits" webinar on July 12 at
